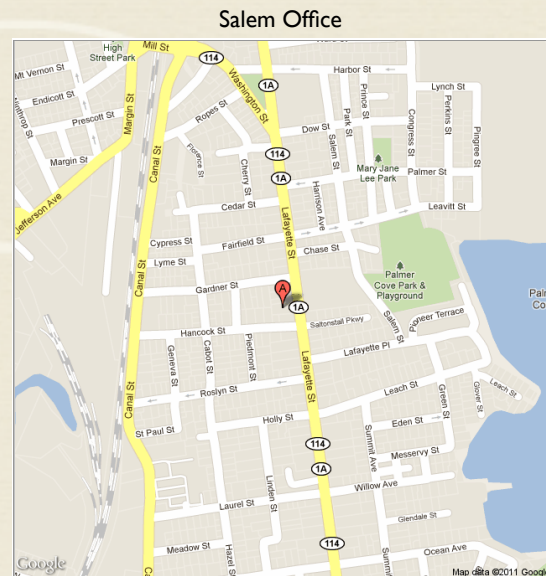
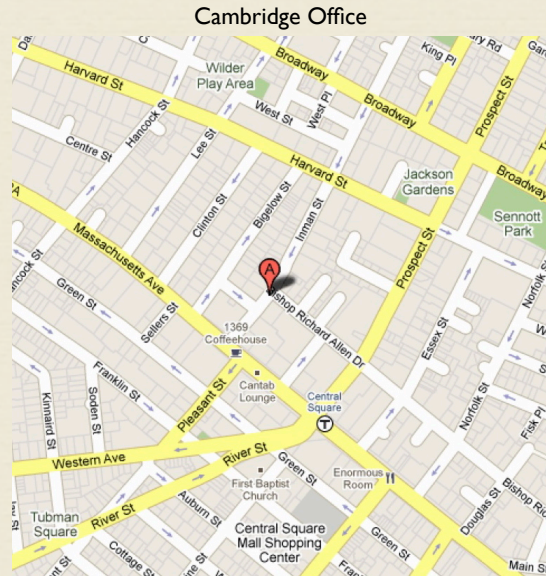


Joseph Doherty, Ed.D., CGP

AREAS OF EXPERTISE

Sexual Offending and Sexual Violence

The staff at New Directions has many years of expertise in the area of sexual offending and sexual violence. Our work has primarily been in the evaluation and treatment of sexual abusers. We bring extensive clinical expertise as well as a thorough knowledge of the research associated with sexual violence, deviant sexuality, recidivism risk, and treatment modalities for offenders.

Victimization and Trauma

Our expertise is also in the area of interpersonal/family violence, victimization, trauma, posttraumatic stress disorder (PTSD), and abuse. We have extensive clinical and research expertise in the area of interpersonal violence, childhood abuse, the evaluation of victims of violence, Posttraumatic stress disorder, and other trauma related psychological sequelae

FORENSIC SERVICES

Psychological Assessment

We provide specialized assessment for sexual offenders and victims of abuse and trauma. Our offender evaluations address forensic issues such as recidivism risk, cognitive functioning, sexual interest, and general psychological functioning and how they relate to service and supervision needs. In evaluating victims, we focus on the psychological impact of abuse and violence and how this affects an individual's functioning and what services may be helpful to the client

Expert Testimony and Consultation

Our staff is able to provide case consultation as well as expert witness testimony. We are experienced in testifying in civil commitment cases and before the Sex Offender Registry Board (SORB). Victim expert witness services are available for both criminal and civil litigation
